SCHOLARSHIP-GRANT INFORMATION - 2021



GENERAL SCHOLARSHP FOR THE NYSCC SCHOLARSHIP FUND

- The General Scholarship for the NYSCC is a general funding for those undergraduate or graduate students who wish to pursue a role in the cosmetic sciences. They must apply and follow the recommended disbursement deadlines and submit their application form online.
- The Scholarship and Grants (S&G Committee meets once a year to review applicants) and submits the selected applicants for approval to the executive board members.
- The applicant should have completed their first year of undergraduate study to apply.
- \$2500 per year meet qualifications reapply when school year is completed until degree completion.
- Must Maintain good standing with the NYSCC and a min 3.0 GPA.
- Applicants must be enrolled in a BS / MS related program related to cosmetic science for at least a parttime schedule.
- Applicants must submit a 500 word essay on why NYSCC should grant you scholarship funding. Student
 must write what they intend to do with their degree upon completion and any cosmetic science related
 initiatives they are currently involved in or hope to be involved in.



GRANTS FOR EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS



- The Grants for Educational Institutions are awarded to those applicants who display their strategic initiatives that advance the promotion of cosmetic science and increase accessibility to knowledge for the continued enrichment of the cosmetic industry.
- Maximum Grant amount per year is \$10,000 and is subject for Executive Board approval.
- Variable amount based on the organization's strategic initiatives and needs 2< more executive board approval. Awards are disbursed 30 Days after approval. S&G Application must be filled out and sent to committee head and then for executive board approval.
- Applicants must include a W9 with their submission.
- Application form must be filled and with required documents to be sent to the Awards Chair for review. The Awards Chair will submit all applicant pool to the S&G Chair for second review and ultimately sent to Executive Board for approval.



ROUMELIA ALINA INCLUSION & DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

The Roumelia Alina Inclusion & Diversity Scholarship is a *value-based* scholarship awarded to those applicants who exemplify Hard Work, Perseverance, Compassion and Collaboration in the advancement of Inclusion & Diversity initiatives. Evidence of the applicant's efforts must be articulated in a 500 word essay.

- Applicants must be enrolled in a BS / MS related program for at least a part- time schedule.
- One (1) selected applicant will be awarded annually.
- Award amount \$ 5000
